Allowed uses include:

- 1 Personal reference.
- 2 Sharing on your personal social media accounts.

- 4 Personal research and private study.
- 5 As a teaching resource in a classroom, school, college or university.
- 6 Reproduction in a dissertation or thesis submitted by a student attending a recognised or listed educational organisation.

Filming, recording and commercial photography is strictly prohibited without prior written permission from Royston Cave.

1. Terms and Conditions

1.1 Visitor photography is not licensed for publishing purposes.

1.2 You may not publish, use or distribute your photos for any commercial purpose and you may not distribute or license to any third party.

1.3 You may not use flash, tripods, special lighting or other protruding camera equipment such as large lenses or selfie sticks.

1.4 Photographs of Royston Cave must be taken from behind the safety railings.

1.5 Recording, filming and commercial photography inside Royston Cave, including its access tunnel, is strictly prohibited without prior written permission.

1.6 You must also adhere to all additional on-site photography signage and rules.

1.7 You must take photographs in a way that does not cause any inconvenience to other visitors or put the cave or its carvings at risk.

1.8 You are welcome to upload the photos they have taken to your personal Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, and other social media with appropriate attribution to Royston Cave.

1.9 By uploading images or other content, including, without limitation, via email or social media, you grant Royston Cave a non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to publish, use and manipulate that content any where, in any way, at any time.

1.10 We reserve the right to stop you taking photographs of Royston Cave if we have any reason to believe that the images will be used beyond the terms of this policy.
